Ingmar Relling [1920-2002] Norway's most internationally renowned furniture designer, as well as one of the greatest contributors to the concept of Scandinavian Design. Relling's top-selling Siesta, his magnum opus, was an icebreaker that opened up international markets to Norwegian furniture exports.

Simplicity, elegance and uncompromising quality were key concepts in all Relling's designs. Sleek, clear lines, not to mention the obvious correlation between design and function, were essential for Ingmar Relling, who was also closely involved with the chair's development after it left the drawing board.

In the design phase, it was crucial for Relling that the chair should be eco-friendly, with optimised use of materials, wood from sustainable forests, maximum durability and reusability. Typical of Ingmar Relling, who, as well as being a designer, was a dedicated humanist, interested in dimensions extending beyond the purely aesthetic.
